



THE CHILD GUARANTEE SETS MOMENTUM FOR DI, BUT MORE CAN BE DONE...







- Many NAPs target child institutionalization drivers: poverty, lack of access to services
- Child Guarantee EU Monitoring and Evaluation Framework include indicators on children in alternative care
- 2024 Commission
 Recommendation on developing and strengthening integrated child protection systems: has a chapter on DI

- 40% of children in alternative care in the EU are still living in large institutions
- Parents of children with disabilities and at risk lack support
- A minority of countries include measures on the creation of systems of Early Childhood Intervention

EARLY CHILDHOOD INTERVENTION

- FOR CHILDREN WITH OR AT RISK OF DISABILITIES & DEVELOPMENTAL ISSUES
- INDIVIDUALISED PLANS OF SUPPORT AROUND FAMILY/CHILD NEEDS
- COACHING FAMILIES
- STRENGHT-BASED
- REQUIRES SYSTEMS STARTING FROM IDENTIFICATION, ASSESSMENTS

NEW MEASURES & MONITORING



- 1. Prioritize prevention in NAPs
- 2. Strengthen family and community services.
- 3. Advocate disability rights, dismantle barriers.
- 4. Support family reunification, independent living.
- 5. Ensure children's meaningful participation.
- 6. Combat stigma and discrimination.
- 7. Disaggregate data across all sectors.
- 8. Monitor prevention and align national to EU monitoring.



EU RECOMMENDATIONS

- 1. Exchange measures on deinstitutionalisation
- 2. Formulate EU guidelines on DI for children
- 3. Increase EU financial tools to create prevention systems
- 4. Ensure UN CRPD implementation
- 5. Cooperate to Implement measures on DI in 2024 Recommendation on social protection for children
